

With the Mvine platform in place, researchers involved in the Liveable Cities programme can engage across geographical and disciplinary boundaries in ways that were never previously possible. They can publish items in any of the ten workspaces, while monthly and quarterly events ensure the dispersed team keeps in regular contact.

All the assets belonging to the programme are uploaded into the centralised repository - from written documents to videos. Importantly, researchers leaving the programme have a place to put their research materials where they can be easily found and used by other team members.

Each asset is accompanied by a description to ensure current and future team members can place it in context within the whole programme. Joanne notes:

"We are using our Mvine solution to share in a way that promotes longevity." Context is massively important."

The solution also allows team members to develop the folder structure as new research emerges, a vital feature when you are constantly adapting your programme to reflect new insight.


The Future
